Passengers increased 22% in March. This marks six months of growth.

This strong rise was due to a number of factors.

- Easter fell in late March.
- In March 2017, Mackay Airport was closed for nearly four days due to Cyclone Debbie.
- After adjusting for these impacts, there was like for like growth of 10% across the month.
- Both the adjusted and unadjusted monthly growth rates are the highest of the past six months.

The 6% annual growth of transit and transfer passengers is due to more people flying on the coastal route. Many of these are workers travelling from homes in regional Queensland to mines throughout the state.
