

Monthly passenger numbers increased 6% in October. Airlines are filling more seats and the monthly load factor on all flights increased by 7% to 76%.

There were 64,000 passengers on the Brisbane route. This route recorded growth of 5,100 (+9%) which offset the suspension of the Sydney-Mackay route. This Sydney suspension is reflected in the 3% monthly seat reduction.

Annual arriving and departing passengers are now showing an increasing trend from the May 2017 level.
